

The Christian Coach Toolbox *OnLine* ***A Foundation in Christ centred Coaching***

Aim

Equip participants with a scripturally grounded, Christian faith-based approach to helping others move forward, in alignment with their personal walk with God.

“And let us consider how we might spur each other on towards love and good deeds....let us encourage one another....” Hebrews 10:24-25

Outcomes

At the end of the programme participants will:

1. Have a Biblically rooted approach to helping themselves and others find and follow God’s purposes in the choices, challenges and opportunities of life.
2. Have deepened personal authenticity and impact for God in whatever sphere of influence they operate.
3. Be part of a growing network of coaches operating from a faith based perspective.

Session 1 & 2:

“And let us consider how we might spur each other on towards love and good deeds....let us encourage one another....” Hebrews 10:24-25

- What is coaching and how scriptural is coaching?
- Introduction to CROSS coaching methodology
- Exploration of key scripturally based techniques: *silence, listening, connecting spiritually.*
- How do we ‘hear’ God? Presence and power of the Holy Spirit; the Word of God
- Personal Learning Log and buddying for reflective practice throughout the programme.

Session 3 & 4:

“So I run straight to the goal with purpose in every step.....” I Cor. 9:26

- Faith in Action and action in faith
- Goal setting *‘In Christ’.*
- Illuminating Questions
- Mindset of the Christian Coach

Session 5 & 6:

“But when the, the spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all truth.” John 16:13

- Facilitating choice; implicit and explicit questions
- Exploring barriers; Thought and language; Limiting and empowering beliefs
- Values and Beliefs
- Identity in Christ

Session 7 & 8:

“Come let us reason together, says the Lord.” Isaiah 1:18

- Metaphor, using biblical stories, characters, and wisdom
- Challenge
- Strengthening action
- Prayer and Blessing

Session 9 & 10

“For we are God’s workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.” Ephesians 2:10

- The KingsCompass – a wheel of Christian life.
- Whole life coaching.

Session 11 & 12:

“As a prisoner for the Lord, I urge you to live a life worthy of the calling you have received.” Ephesians 4:19

- Application of learning in sacred and secular contexts
- Preparing to coach others: Conversational openings, 1-2-1 Contracting
- Review and Action Planning.
